Counseling Fees

Outcome-Based Counseling Model

At Asaro Education, we believe our success is tied to yours. Unlike most counselors who charge the full fee upfront, we structure our fees in two installments — because we want you to experience our guidance, support, and commitment before making your full investment. This model reflects the confidence we have in our process and the value we deliver.

First Installment: Initial Fee due before the counseling process begins. This confirms your enrollment and secures your spot with your dedicated counselor.

Second Installment: Success Fee due within 10 days of receiving all admission decisions — and must be paid before Asaro Education initiates any visa guidance or post-admission support. No exceptions will be made to this timeline.

VERY IMPORTANT: The second installment is calculated as the **higher** of a fixed amount or 5% of the total scholarship package offered by the university the student chooses to enroll in. In the event the student receives multiple admission offers with varying scholarships, the 5% will be applied to the scholarship amount of the university the student accepts — not the highest offer received.

Example calculation for second installment:

If you receive a \$50,000 per year scholarship for a 4-year bachelors degree:
→ $\$50,000 \times 4 = \$200,000$ total scholarship
→ 5% of \$200,000 = \$10,000 will be the second installment

(For transfer pathway students it would be multiplied by 2-3 depending on remaining years.)

If No Scholarship is Offered: If a student is admitted to one or more universities but receives no scholarship or financial aid of any kind, the fixed flat fee amount of the second installment applies. The percentage-based calculation only applies when a scholarship or aid package is offered.

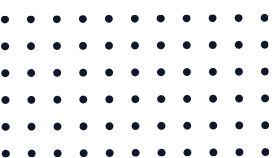

Important Terms and Conditions

On Admission Decisions: Asaro Education provides expert guidance, strategy, and support throughout the application process. However, final admission decisions rest solely with the universities. We do not and cannot guarantee admission to any specific institution or the receipt of any specific scholarship or financial aid package. University selection priorities, application strategy, and school categorization (aspirational, target, safety) are all finalized collaboratively during the shortlisting phase. Students and families cannot revise these preferences after the shortlist has been mutually signed off.

On the University List: The university list is considered final once both parties have approved and signed off on the shortlist. Requests to add, remove, or replace universities after this point are at the sole discretion of the counselor and may not always be accommodated. Students are expected to commit to the agreed list and cannot selectively pursue only certain universities on the list after applications have been submitted.

On Engaging a Second Counselor: The student and family agree not to engage another educational counselor for the same application cycle without prior consultation with Asaro Education. If at any point you feel unsatisfied with our guidance or approach, we encourage you to raise it with us directly — we are committed to open communication and will work with you to find a resolution. We believe that concerns addressed early lead to better outcomes for everyone.

On the Second Installment: The second installment is mandatory upon receiving admission outcomes, regardless of which university the student ultimately chooses to attend. The following circumstances do not waive the second installment obligation:

- Choosing not to attend any of the universities that offered admission
- Second installment is due in full before starting the visa process
- Receiving a university-granted deferral (where a university offers the student entry in a future intake rather than the current one)
- Changing personal, financial, or family circumstances after the process has begun

The only exception: if a student receives rejections from every single university applied to, the second installment will not be charged. Asaro Education is proud to share that since its founding in 2021, this has never occurred.

On When the 10-Day Clock Starts: The 10-day payment window begins on the date the final pending university responds with a decision — whether that decision is an admission offer, waitlist, or rejection. If the second installment is not received within 10 calendar days of the trigger date, Asaro Education reserves the right to withhold any further services including but not limited to visa processing and scholarship negotiations.

On Refunds: All fees paid to Asaro Education are strictly non-refundable.

On Deferrals: If a student voluntarily chooses to defer their enrollment or take a gap year, the initial engagement fee is non-transferable to a future academic cycle.

On Payment Methods: Our bank account is with Chase Bank in the USA. Fees may be paid via international wire transfer, credit card or domestically within the USA.

On Student Personal Data: Asaro Education reserves the right to feature the student's photo and a general overview of their admissions journey on our website and social media platforms for promotional purposes. No confidential information will be shared without prior consent.

Student & Parent Responsibilities: The student is responsible for completing all assigned tasks on time, attending scheduled sessions, and providing accurate and complete academic information. Delays caused by the student's unresponsiveness or incomplete submissions are not the responsibility of Asaro Education.

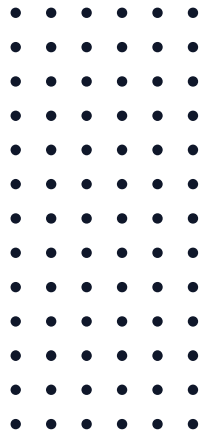
